- Pointing system: 1 point for a win, 0,5 for a draw and 0 for a loss.
- Tie-Break system: Buchholz Cut-1, Buchholz, Sonnenborg-Berger, Progress. In case of a round-robin tournament, the tie-break system will be: Sonnenborg-Berger, Koya, number of wins.

- Winners are obliged to attend the Closing Ceremony in order to receive awards and prizes.

#### 11. ORGANIZATIONAL MATTERS

- The organiser is responsible for all the playing gear.
- The club or the legal guardian is responsible for taking care, health condition and insurance
  of the player taking part in the tournament (if he is underage).
- Maximum delay for a round is 30 minutes in the classical tournament and until the time on the clock runs out in the blitz tournament.
- There is no limit for draw offers.
- The organiser has the right to change the regulations.
- The Chief Arbiter decides all the arguments and his decisions are indisputable. You may have a **turned off** mobile phone in the playing hall.

 Any participant being under the influence of alcohol will be kicked out of the tournament by the Chief Arbiter and no costs will be returned.

#### 12. CLOSING REMARKS

- Participation in the tournament is equivalent to accepting the regulations,
- The organiser doesn't take responsibility for any accidents which may occur during the tournament.
- Participants agree to have their personal data processed according to article 6 act 1 item a
  of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April
  2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data
  and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data
  Protection Regulation).
